#### **Digital Game: Stu's Super Stunts**



Stu needs your help with trying different ways to do tricks!

Materials: paper towel/toilet paper roll, paper plates

**Activity:** First, cut the center out of a few paper plates to make "rings." Next, stand your toilet paper or paper towel roll up. Now that everything is ready to go, try to throw your ring onto the paper towel roll.

Encourage your child to test different things out, moving the roll closer, further away, throwing harder, throwing softer, using a smaller object like a pony tail to try to get on the roll, there's no wrong way to do it!

#### Questions to ask along the way:

"What would happen if you threw your ring really hard?" "Do you think you could do it with a ponytail holder?"
